Title, Works Cited, should be centered on top of page. Double space entire page. Left align first line of each citation and indent subsequent lines.

1. Book with one author:

Grisham, John. *The Last Juror*. New York: Doubleday, 2004. Print.
Author's last name, first name. *Title*. City of Publication: Publisher, Copyright date. Medium.

2. Book with two authors:

Eggs, Suzanne, and Diana Slade. *Analyzing Casual Conversation*. London: Cassell, 1997. Print.
Same as one author except second author's name begins with their first name.

3. Book with an editor:

Bloom, Harold, Ed. *Gabriel Garcia Marquez*. NY: Chelsea House, 1989. Print.
Editor's last name, first name, ed. *Title*. City of Publication.: Publisher, Copyright date. Medium.

4. Article in reference book with an author's name:

Goldsmith, Oliver. "She Stoops To Conquer." *World Literature and Its Times*. Ed. Moss, Joyce. Vol. 7. Detroit: Thompson Gale, 2005. Print.
Author. "Title of article." *Title of reference book*. Editor. Vol. City of publication: Publisher, Copyright date. Medium.

5. Article in reference book without an author's name:

"Joseph Lister." *Encyclopedia of World Biography* 2nd ed. Detroit: Gale Research, 1998. Print.
"Title of article." *Title of Reference Book*. Edition. City of publication: Publisher, Copyright date. Medium.

6. Book with a corporate author:

The Boston Women's Health Book Collective. *Our Bodies, Ourselves*. New York: Simon and Schuster, 1998. Print.
Name of corporation that is responsible for the content of the book. *Title*. City of Publication: Publisher, Copyright date. Medium.

7. Article in a magazine:

Weintraub, Arlene, and Laura Cohen. "A Thousand-Year Plan for Nuclear Waste." *Business Week*. 6 May 2002: 94-96. Print.
Author(s). "Title of article." *Name of magazine*. Date of publication: Pages. Medium.

8. Personal Interview:

Last name, first name (of person being interviewed). Personal interview. 1 Nov. 2005.

Title. Director's name. Performers. Date created. Format. Distributor. Date released in this format. Medium.

Name of individual program (episode). *Name of TV series*. Name of narrator. Name of Director. Call Letters of city of local station. Broadcast date. Medium.
