

**Graduation by Proficiency**  
**Also know as**  
**Proficiency Based Graduation Requirements (PBGR's)**

**All students in the Warwick district are required to have a minimum of 22 Carnegie units to graduate. These credits must include:**

English	4 credits	
Math	4 credits	one can be an applied math course
Science	3 credits	
Social studies	3 credits	World, and U.S History required
Computer studies	1 credits	
Fine arts	1 credits	
Foreign Language	2 credits	college prep only
Phys. Ed.	2 credits	4 years @ .5 for each year
Health/Family Life	1 credit	4 years @ .25 for each year

**The class of 2008 must also complete a senior project**  
**Beginning with the class of 2009, all Warwick District students must complete the required credits and take all end of course exams, complete a Senior project, an electronic Portfolio, take the state tests in mathematics, English and science, and complete an Individual Learning Plan senior transition page.**

**Students progress from freshman to sophomore year by completing 4.75 credits.**  
**Students progress to the junior year when they have completed 9.50 credits.**  
**To become a senior, students must have 15.25 credits and be able to fit all remaining required courses in their senior schedule.**
